TIER 1

Enhance services to victims of sexual violence and the community based programs who serve them	<p><i>Ensure that every child who has been the victim of sexual abuse gets the care and support they need.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Enhancing services for child victims of sexual abuse seen at Community Sexual Assault Programs (CSAPs).</i> • <i>Increasing CSAP's sexual assault prevention efforts</i> • <i>Reviewing and updating Child Sexual Abuse Protocols in every county</i>
Employment leave for crime victims	<p><i>Support efforts to ensure victims of domestic violence, sexual violence, and stalking have time off from their employer without risking the loss of their job</i></p>

TIER 2

Sex offender management and re-entry; increasing community guardianship	<p><i>Support proposals which address the sentencing, release, supervision, housing and overall management of adult and juvenile sex offenders through tested and replicable tools and strategies to help communities effectively cope with convicted sex offenders.</i></p>
Establish a standing sex offender management board	<p><i>Support the planning and implementation of a policy board to advise the Governor and Legislature regarding sex offender management</i></p>
Amending the rules of evidence	<p><i>Support the amendment of the rules of evidence to allow easier admission of background information on sex offenders at trial.</i></p>

Crime victim input regarding offender re-entry	<p><i>Support mechanisms for crime victims to provide input to the Department of Corrections regarding offender reentry</i></p>
Modifying address confidentiality program provisions	<p><i>Support the addition of eligibility for victims of stalking and human trafficking to the address confidentiality program</i></p>
Revising the Penalty Provisions for indecent exposure	<p><i>Support the revising of the penalty provisions for indecent exposure</i></p>
